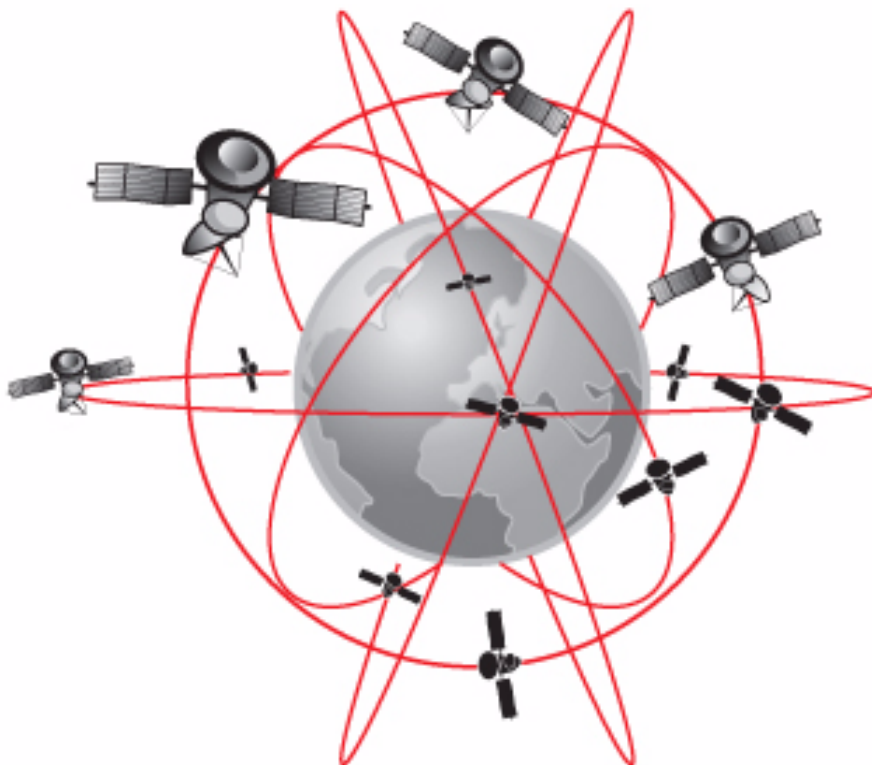

Introduction

With Location services you can get help to find your way, view information about your current location and save your favourite locations.

Before you start

To use all features of Location services, you need to be able to access the Internet with your phone. If you cannot access the Internet, see the *Using the Internet* Getting started guide.

Using GPS to find your location

Your phone is equipped with a GPS (Global Positioning System) receiver that uses satellite signals to calculate your location. Make sure you have a clear view of the sky when using features that require the GPS receiver to find your location. If your location is not found after a few minutes, move to another location. To facilitate the search, stand still and hold your phone according to the illustration.



To check your satellite coverage

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Status info.**
2. Scroll to the **Connection status** tab. Your location can be found when three or more satellites are used.

Assisted GPS

With Assisted GPS (A-GPS) it takes less time to calculate a location.

Google Maps™ for mobile

Google Maps™ lets you view maps and satellite imagery, find addresses and local businesses, and calculate routes.

To search for an address

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Google Maps.**
2. Select **Options > Find Location.**
3. Select **Enter an address.**
4. Enter the address and select **OK.**
5. Select **OK.**

 To save the found location, press **(1)** and select **Save as a favourite.**

To search for a local business

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Google Maps.**
2. Select **Options > Find Business.**
3. Select **Enter a new search.**
4. Enter the business name or a category and select **OK.**
5. Select **OK.**

 To save the found location, press **(1)** and select **Save as a favourite.**

To view satellite imagery

- When you use Google Maps™, select **Options > Satellite View.**

To calculate routes

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Google Maps.**
2. Select **Options > Directions.**
3. Select **Enter an address.** Enter the start point address and select **OK.**
4. Select **OK.**
5. Select **Enter an address.** Enter the end point address and select **OK.**
6. Select **OK.**
7. Press **(3)** to view the directions.

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Google Maps.**
2. Select **Options > Help.**

Saved locations

All locations you save are found in **My favourites**.

To show a saved location on the map

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > My favourites**.
2. Scroll to a location and select **Go to**.

 When you use Google Maps you can press  to access your favourites.

To view position details for a saved location

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > My favourites**.
2. Scroll to a location.
3. Scroll left or right.

Logged locations

Your location is automatically saved in a log at a set interval.

To show a logged location on the map

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Log**.
2. Scroll to a date and time and select **Show**.

To save a logged location

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Log**.
2. Scroll to a date and time and select **Options > Add as favourite**.
3. Select **Edit** and enter the title. Select **OK**.
4. Scroll to **Description:** and select **Add**. Enter the description and select **OK**.
5. Select **Save**.

GPS status information

When your location is found you can view available satellites and get information about your current speed and altitude.

To view GPS status

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Status info**.
2. Scroll between the tabs.

Location requests

External services may ask for your location. You can change settings to allow or restrict external services to use information about your location.

To change permission for external services

1. From standby select **Menu > Location services > Settings > Permission**.
2. Select an option.

Disabling the GPS

The GPS receiver is automatically disabled when it is no longer used. You can also manually disable the GPS receiver. This saves battery power when using features that do not require the GPS receiver to find your location.

- ! When the GPS receiver has been manually disabled you need to enable it manually.

To disable the GPS

- From standby select **Menu > Location services > Settings > Disable GPS**.

To enable the GPS

- From standby select **Menu > Location services > Settings > Enable GPS**.
