

Sony Ericsson Mobile Communications RoHS Compliance Statement

Since 1 January 2006, products, including handsets, wireless devices, accessories and spare parts, placed on the market by Sony Ericsson Mobile Communications and its legal entities under the brand name of Sony Ericsson, are compliant with the requirements laid down in Directive 2002/95/EC¹ (the EU RoHS directive).

The consistency of Sony Ericsson products with the EU RoHS directive applies to all markets. Accordingly, Sony Ericsson products do not contain any of those substances listed in article 4 of that directive, except for what is permitted in article 2, paragraph 3 (spare parts for older electronic equipment) and for those uses exempted under the annex to the directive.
